Girl's & Boy's Talent Showcase

- The NCSA/AVCA Girl's Talent Showcase is a recruiting event developed for coaches attending the AVCA Convention. Uncommitted and unsigned female high school student-athletes as well as junior college players will be invited to participate.
- The event will consist of three waves of athletes with the first wave beginning at 8:30 a.m. and the third wave finishing at 1 p.m. on Sunday, December 17. The Talent Showcase will take place in Hall D of the Kansas City Convention Center.
- The NCAA has granted an exemption for coaches to participate so make plans to stay over on Sunday for this event.
- The AVCA Boy's Talent showcase is a recruiting event developed for coaches attending the AVCA Convention. Uncommitted and unsigned male high school student-athletes as well as junior college players will be invited to participate.
- The event will consist of one wave of athletes which will be held from 2 – 3:30 p.m. on Saturday, December 16 in Hall D of the Kansas City Convention Center.



Other Things You Should Know

- **The AVCA Career Center is located in the AVCA Volleyball Marketplace. You can post your resume, view open positions, schedule an interview room, schedule individual sessions with a career counselor, participate in career development roundtable discussions, have a professional headshot photo taken and more.**
- **Make sure to visit the AVCA Coaches Zone presented by The Art of Coaching Volleyball. Located in Volleyball Marketplace, this is your area to meet friends and take a break from the day. A phone charging station and complimentary massage tables will be available. The AVCA will also have an auction in Volleyball Marketplace with items ranging from uniforms and recruiting software to volleyballs and training equipment.
